

Smithtown Center for the Performing Arts' Theatre Education Program (TEP) - SUMMER CAMP 2007

Smithtown Center for the Performing Arts' Theatre Education Program Summer Camp is an intensive theatre training program, it is designed to give all students, novices and seasoned performers alike, the opportunity to participate in the theatre experience. While we would like to think all participants will become active theatre participants, the goals of each session are to give the student a creative, collaborative atmosphere that fosters their self-esteem and communication skills.

Important Information

- Camp is held daily, Monday - Friday, 9:00 am - 3:00 pm for 3 weeks
- Session 1 - July 2 - July 20, 2007 (Showcase, July 21, 2007, 10:00 am)
- Session 2 - August 6 - August 24, 2007 (Showcase, Aug. 25, 2007, 10:00 am)
- All students will take part in a showcase at the end of each 3-week session.
- We accept youth Ages 7 -18. At the first meeting of the camp-students will audition for the teachers and then will be divided into groups, age and ability will determine group placement.
- First time enrollees in our TEP Program must pay a \$40.00 administration fee.
- All classes will meet at the Smithtown Center for the Performing Arts.
- Enrollment is limited to 45 youth per session.
- No transportation or food is provided by the TEP Program. Youth must be transported to and from the theatre by either a parent or guardian, or an authorized individual of the camp enrollee. All students should bring their own bag lunch and snacks. No youth will be permitted to leave the facility at any time. (i.e. they can not go around the corner for pizza or ice cream).
- A lottery for parents who wish to accompany their child on the field trip will be held the 1st day of camp.

PROGRAM DETAILS: This is an intensive theatre program. Students spend all their time working on theatre projects. (No sports or recreation breaks)

Students will spend the morning in classes including dance, vocal technique, acting technique and improvisation. The afternoon will be spent in rehearsals.

For rehearsals the students will be broken up into small groups where they will work with a theatrical professional to mount a short production. Production content will be chosen by the instructors, and students will be cast by the staff on the first day of classes through a painless audition process. This will also help us to determine the best class placement for the students. Final class and show placements will be determined by our instructors. This will help us to insure each student's success as well as the success of the program.

- \$40.00 ONE-TIME ADMINISTRATION FEE FOR NEW STUDENTS.

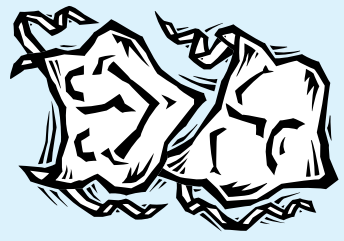
